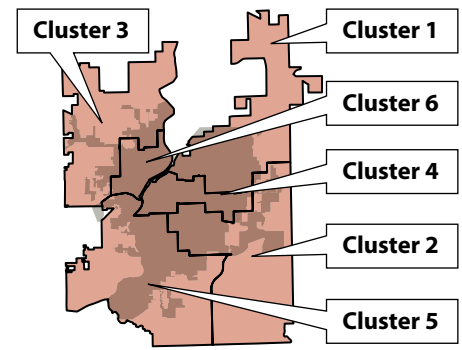


Neighborhood zones would shift school enrollments

Enrollment in the Rockford School District will shift under a plan to create neighborhood-based elementary school boundary zones. Most noticeable is a shift in the northeast quadrant of Rockford, which would see a significant dip in the number of students from low-income families. Schools where more than 90 percent of the student population are from low-income families, would see the enrollment numbers stay the same or grow.
